**1) Start by the corner of Balgreen Road and Gorgie Road and cross the bridge into the park.**

**Easy: What's underneath you as you cross the bridge?**

**Tricky: Which two stations are named on the sign-post at the path junction?**

**2) Now turn left on the path that goes along the river.**

**Easy: Near the weir, there are bird boxes in the trees. How many can you see?**

**Tricky: What kind of tree gave Saughton Park its name?**

**3) At the end of the riverside path, turn right towards the adults' outdoor gym.**

**Easy: How many bit of apparatus are there for grown-ups to use?**

**Tricky: How much physical activity does the Outdoor Gym recommend per week?**

**4) Cycle towards the playpark.**

**Easy: What colour is the big slide?**

**Tricky: How many metal triangles are in the blue climbing frame?**

**5) Now head past the skate-park and turn left. Cycle all the way around the edge of the pitches to the Stevenson Drive entrance.**

**Easy: How many football goals can you see?**

**Tricky: Look on the entrance sign. What model number is the bandstand?**
