1) Start by the statue on Newhaven Road.

Easy: How many spaces are there for hire bikes in the stand?

Tricky: What number is the Roman numeral on the statue?

2) Now go towards the small playpark..

Easy: What colour are the swings in the small playpark near Newhaven road?

Tricky: How many small triangles are in the climbing frame in the small playpark?

3) Find the big sign near the path to Trinity school.

Easy: Name the types of play equipment in the old picture of the park.

Tricky: What was the park originally called?

4) Cycle towards the notice board near Craighall Road.

Easy: What colour is the flag that's flying in the park?

Tricky: When was the flag awarded?

5) Now head towards the pitches for playing sports.

Easy: How many benches are there for people to watch the sports?

Tricky: What kind of sports are the pitches/courts marked for?
